THE POOR WERE HELPED BY GIVING RATION IN CORONA



As the country recovers, it seems we are lagging behind, where hunger still remains an urgency, even if not a pandemic.

People have been suffering for almost 1 months now, and very soon, we will reach the point of hunger crisis; They will die of hunger before the virus is caught.

Ambedkaar samaj kalyan sabha is an initiative which is feeding the poor and unemployed who are struggling to feed themselves during the lockdown.

We have managed to distribute more and more food to the needy since the first lockdown through cooked meals and ration kits.

Since the first lockdown, we have been helping people in most areas in karnal.

These areas are home to migrants, daily wage workers, rickshaw pullers, rag pickers etc – who were unemployed and struggling to afford basic food.

We have expanded our efforts whenever the need arose and the need was at its peak.

Our NGO members came forward and pledged to help all those people who were suffering badly and lost their livelihood.

To ensure that food is not wasted, Feeding From Far is distributing ration kits that last a whole week to a family of 5. The ration kit consists of:

- 1) Rice 7 kg
- 2) Wheat 7 kg
- 3) Chana dal 1.5 kg
- 4) sugar 1 kg
- 5) oil 1 liter.
- 6) salt 1 kg
- 7) Turmeric powder 150 grams.
- 8) Red chili powder 150 grams

He described himself as an "executive president" who worked "within the four corners of the Constitution"; Something in between an "executive chairman" who has direct power and a "rubber-stamp chairman" who supports government decisions without question or deliberation.

He exercised his discretionary powers as president and deviated from tradition and precedent in a number of situations, including - but not limited to - the appointment of a prime minister in a hung parliament, the dismissal of a state government and Union Cabinet on the suggestion of imposition of President's rule and during Kargil conflict.
